RESOLUTION 01 – 03

Whereas the Knights of Columbus are occasionally called upon to assist those in need and

Whereas this assistance could be in the form of money, goods or services and

Whereas Supreme council by-laws prohibits the expenditure of council funds in excess of 200.00 dollars without approval of a resolution per sec. 122-B of the by-laws and

Whereas the need for assistance may be on an emergency basis and time does not permit the formal processing of a resolution,

Therefore be it resolved that Council 8150, establish a charities fund of 8500.00 dollars, for the purchase of goods or services to be donated to those in need and

Be it further resolved that this resolution be the authority to disburse amounts in excess of 200.00 dollars, from the charities fund, upon council approval.

Be it finally resolved that disbursements from this fund shall not exceed the fund balance at the time the council approves the request for donation.

RESOLUTION 02 - 03

Whereas the Kent council, 8150, conducts many social functions during the fraternal year and

Whereas some of these functions require funding prior to the activity for tickets, food, supplies, etc. and

Whereas Supreme Council by-laws prohibits the expenditure of council funds in excess of 200.00 dollars without approval of a resolution per sec. 122-B of the by-laws.

Therefore be it resolved that by the authorization of the Kent council to conduct the activities, the chairperson of the event be provided up to 700.00 dollars in advance and

Be it finally resolved that the chairperson of the event, upon completion, present to the council a written report of the financial results and return to the council financial secretary, the funds advanced prior to the disbursement of the balance of the event funds.
