BREAKFAST WORKERS

A big thanks for all you have done this year. At the first March meeting it was bought up that we only have one worker who has a valid food handler's permit. The permits are issued by the State of Washington at some of their Health Clinics. At the Health Clinic on Cemetery Road in Renton (Across from Renton Vo-Tec) they will administer the test and issue the permits on Mondays; 2:30 to 6:00PM. All the food workers, both in the kitchen and the dining room, are encouraged to get an up-to-date permit. This costs only \$5.00 for the permit and it is an open-book test. We should have at least two people with a current food handler's permit at every event involving food.
