STAMPS

On Sept. 5th, the United States Postal Service will dedicate a new stamp honoring Blessed Teresa of Calcutta. She was an independent, yet obedient woman born Agnes Gonxha Bojaxhiu on Aug. 26, 1910 in Skopje, Macedonia. In 1979, Mother



Teresa won the Nobel Peace Prize for her humanitarian works. In 1997 the US Congress awarded her the Congressional Gold Medal for her "outstanding and enduring contributions through humanitarian and charitable activities." These are but two of her numerous awards and accolades.

Her life was dedicated to loving and caring for the poorest among us which she did for many years in Calcutta, where in 1950 she started the order known as The Missionaries of Charity. Although originally nuns, today the Society comprises nuns, brothers and priests and has spread worldwide.

It was heard...

Brothers and sisters: Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen. Because of it the ancients were well attested.



By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to a place that he was to receive as an inheritance; he went out, not knowing where he was to go. By faith he sojourned in the promised land as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, heirs of the same promise; for he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and maker is God.

By faith he received power to generate, even though he was past the normal age—and Sarah herself was sterile—for he thought that the one who had made the promise was trustworthy.
