Thur., Feb. 2, 2012 — 6:30 pm**

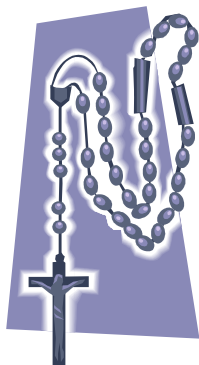

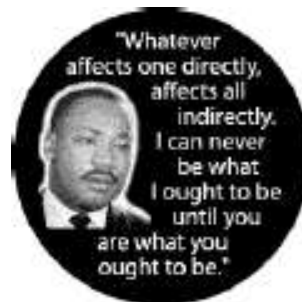
