On our way home from the hand warmer trip tonight we stopped and got the mail. In the mail was a check for just over \$300 from Geico. The message said they had determined we were entitled to a lower rate and were refunding the balance. Completely unexpected and about the same amount as we recently spent on the homeless. Is God amazing or what.
